Bibleville Kids Place Easter Lily Blossoms On Nails Of The

Cross. Upon arriving on Good Friday and before entering the nave, we hammered a nail into the cross which is standing outside next to the tomb. The nail symbolized Jesus' death for our sins. This morning during Bibleville, the 3rd & 4th graders and the Preteens placed an Easter Lily on each of the nails. The cross is in the circle drive island. Please look as you pass through the foyer after our divine service. Easter lilies are a symbol of purity and the resurrection of Jesus Christ. The lily's trumpet-like shape and pure white color symbolizes our joyful proclamation of His resurrection and the new life He has won for us.
