Listening Posts Beginning in February Listening Posts are opportunities for Grace members to share their "stories" about their membership at Grace Lutheran Church. There will be a few "probing" questions offered prior to the Posts (in the February newsletter) to help everyone think about what they want to share. The Posts will be held at various times on various days of the week. Each group will be limited to <u>no more than 10 participants</u> and will last for 60-90 minutes. Sign-up sheets are on a table near the Community Room next to the 2025 contribution envelopes. The goal of this exercise is to gather as much information on the "what was" (i.e., history) of the Grace congregation to help us understand the "what is" (current situation) of our church. Further events will help us determine the "what will be" (future) of our mutual mission and ministry. We need at least 65% of the current worship attendance (about 78 participants) to get a good reading on the congregation.

VBS Team: The VBS team will be comprised of Team "Mates." Each Team "Mate" will be responsible for planning, organizing and recruiting servants to help on his/her team. Talk to Ms. Carol if you have questions. Team "Mates" are needed for the following areas:

Decorations - Sanctuary, Main Hallway, Fellowship Hall, Bible Story Room and Entryway. Workshops can be scheduled to help with cutting out or whatever needs to be done with decorations. We can decorate the week before VBS.

Games – Three Days of Games / Activities for (30 min.) outdoors or in the gym that go along with the day's Bible Story or VBS Theme. (Age appropriate) Make a list of any supplies that will be needed.
